## PERFORMER & WORKSHOP PRESENTER'S GUIDELINES

Festuri's aim is to provide entertainment that represents multiculturalism on the Sunshine Coast. Performances that can be enjoyed by families and include crowd participation, audience interaction, workshops or demonstrations are most preferred. Workshops can be delivered to specific age groups.

### Selection Process

- 1 August 2010 - Deadline for receiving Applications (Receipt of all applications will be acknowledged)
- 14 September 2010 - Contracts will be sent to selected performers
- 30 September 2010 - Deadline for submission of Contracts
- Application and Contract forms must be filled-out completely or they will not be accepted
- Acts will not be more than 45 minutes (inclusive stage preparation)
- All performers must carry their own Public Liability Insurance
- FESTURI will deal only with the contact person appointed in the Performers Contract. This contact person is responsible for passing on information to all performers that he/she represents.
- Number of performers stated in the contract must be maintained. Additional performers must be approved by Festuri.
- Acts are free to swap members (within reason) or invite other performers who are booked to perform at the festival to join them as guest musicians ONLY upon approval by Festuri – a Multicultural Celebration Inc.
- Workshops delivered to children require a Working with Children (Blue Card)

### Selection Criteria

- 1) Type of Material:** The Multicultural nature of this Festival covers a broad spectrum of music styles, both traditional and contemporary. Please send biographies, photos and video in digital format on a CD to support your application.
- 2) Type of Performances:** Performers offering workshops and themed presentations are preferred to those offering just concert performances. We also seek performers who can present plays and dances for children.
- 4) Fees:** Festuri – a Multicultural Celebration Inc. is a small, not-for-profit event with a limited budget. Please take this into consideration when quoting a fee. Be realistic if you wish your application to be considered. All fees quoted are to be totally inclusive of all costs such as GST, travel, visas and meals.
- 5) Street performers, buskers:** Artists are welcome to apply but the number of such acts is limited and must not interfere with scheduled performances. Acts suitable for young children will be considered (e.g. clowns, magic acts, puppeteers, kid's crafts, etc) for a children's program.
